## A better assessment for all

### Students get a better assessment

Tailored testing (where questions adjust to the ability of a student as he or she goes through the test) will give students questions better suited to their achievement level.

### Parents get their child's results faster

Marking NAPLAN Online using automated scoring means results will be available within weeks, rather than months.

### Teachers have access to more precise results

The precision and improved timing of NAPLAN Online results will help teachers tailor their teaching more specifically to student needs.

### Reliability safeguarded and demonstrated

Since 2012, significant planning, development, research and trialling have taken place to ensure the soundness of the online assessment model and to assist the transition to NAPLAN Online.

### Adjustments for students with disability

Adjustments will allow students with disability to participate in NAPLAN tests so that all students can demonstrate what they know. A student may have access to more than one adjustment during a test. Adjustments available for NAPLAN Online tests are at least equivalent to those currently available for NAPLAN paper tests.

### Schools have the flexibility to spread the tests

The NAPLAN Online testing window is extended from three to nine days, so schools will not need a device for every single student. Alternative IT solutions for those without internet connectivity will be made available.

### State/territory governments choose when they go online

Federal, state and territory education ministers agreed that NAPLAN will move online over the next two to three years.
